The story is penned by leading Urdu-short story writer Sadat Hasan Manto after partition of India. The play was graced by enthusiastic participation of students and various faculty members who were all geared up to attend the same.

#### About the play:

Religious violence in India includes acts of violence by followers of one religious group against followers and institutions of another religious group, often in the form of rioting.Religious violence in India has generally

involved Hindus and Muslims. The partition displaced between 10-12 million people along religious lines, creating overwhelming refugee crises in the newly constituted dominions;

there was large-scale violence, with estimates of loss of life. The violent nature of the partition created an atmosphere of hostility and suspicion between India and Pakistan that plagues their relationship to the present.

Our play showcased this disease of bitterness which grew among every single person including Muhammad and Jugal, two close friends who couldn't even imagine a day without each other but later became the part of partition ending with jugal killing Muhammad because of their religious fights , after partition was announced, the subcontinent descended quickly into riots and bloodshed resulting not only open killing of Hindus and Muslims but also murder of their unbreakable yet breakable relationships.



We are extremely thankful to our teacher co-ordinator Dr. Aditi R. Khandelwal who always keep us encouraged to prepare such theatre pieces and giving us innumerable opportunities to perform the same.

## **GUEST LECTURE: SHRI NIRANJAN GOSWAMI**

"We make the visible invisible and the invisible visible."

This is how Padmashri Niranjan Goswami describes his art form: mime.

On the 9<sup>th</sup> of September, 2019, Shri Niranjan Goswami visited the IIS University as a guest lecturer and guided the students of the Theatrical Society about the foundation of mime in India and its origin. Shri Niranjan Goswami was born in 1949, Dhaka, Bangladesh. He trained in mime with Jogesh Dutta from 1966 to 1969 at the latter's institution Padaboli, and trained himself in theatre working with Sombhu Mitra at Bohurupee between 1970 and 1975. He established the Indian Mime Theatre in 1976. Shri Goswami has advanced the practice of mime as an independent genre in Indian theatre with his performances over the past two decades.

Among his significant productions are Sonarganyer Meye (1983), Dena Paona (1989), Srikanta (1990), Beej (1995), and Nagamandala (1997). Most of these are based on wellknown literary works. To build up an audience for mime, Shri Goswami has been organizing festivals of mime theatre since the mid-1980s. He has also taught mime at several institutions, including the National School of Drama in Delhi, the Trissur School of Drama, and the Film and Television Institute of India, Pune. He has given lecture- demonstrations at the University of California at Los Angeles, U.S.A., and the Jawaharlal Nehru University in Delhi. Shri Goswami has been working with deaf children for several years, some of whom have won young Talent Scholarships of the Government of India. He has performed in the World Youth Festival (1989) in Pyongyang, North Korea, and the Shanghai International Art Festival (2002) in China, and has besides toured Europe, the former Soviet Union, and the United States as a cultural delegate.



Among other honours, he has received the All India Critics Association Award in 1998. He was awarded a Senior Research Fellowship by the Department of Culture, Government of India, in 2001.

Shri Niranjan Goswami received the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award for his excellence as an actor in mime. As part of the lecture, Sir illustrated the intricacies of mime. He taught the students the relevance of painting the face in mime, how the whole body acts instead of words, the extraction of mime from Natyashastra as 'Mukhabhinaya' and many such things. Currently, Sir has founded the National Mime Institute in Kolkata that gives a post graduate course in theatre. For the students, it was an enlightening experience to meet somebody with such a powerful aura. Sir left them with an insight to the world of mime. He taught the students how one must incarnate oneself into the object so as to understand the art. It was an enriching experience to say the least.

## ANNUAL PLAY 2019-20

The students of the IISU Theatrical Society staged their Annual Play 2019 titled "Ek Bhoot Ki Atmakatha" on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2019. The play was a culmination of a 30 day workshop that taught the participants various styles of theatre, disciplines and etiquettes of working on stage.

The Chief Guest of the play was, the renowned theatre and film artist, Ms. Ratna Pathak Shah. She not only acknowledged the teams' efforts into creating the play but also provided useful insights about what the focus points while performing should be. The entirety of the play was a result of a lot of time put in and had its own moments. After all, Rome wasn't built in day.

#### Process and milestones of the workshop:

The journey of 30 days was a splendid one. Each step, leading the students to become better actors and moreover, better people with strong personas. The workshop began with the basic step of familiarization. Introducing themselves, the students' ideas and reasons to join theatre acted as a small window to knowing the team. They got to know the director, Mr. Siva Prasad Tumu and understood his expectations from the play, the team and his work ethics. The very next step and one of the most important one was that of interpretation. It involved looking at the play beyond literal levels of understanding. Participants pondered upon the message these stories are trying to convey and how they link them to the real world. Through this, they got an outlook upon how the participants were not there as blank slates but came with their own set of thoughts which needed to be spoken out. Portrayal through improvisations was a very intriguing step of the process. It not only showed how creative the participants were but also brought out their opinions in a structured manner.

Each group gave different forms of the same story in different styles like mime, musical or dance drama or through plain narratives but with intricate formats. Through these improvisations, the director moved on to character blocking. This was done through linking the participants' personalities with the characters' needs. Each person brought their own eccentrics and ideography as a contribution to the characters' development. Once the blocking was complete, the plot as a whole was formed. The loop holes were understood and covered and each story was worked upon numerous times with several different styles. In this, our acting trainers, Mr. Jagannath Seth and Mr. Mahesh Godeshwar, played a significant role. The participants were introduced to Chaau dance and Pina Bausch's style of theatrics. Mr. Seth made them understand the importance of inculcating the habit of feeling the rhythm of the music and the essence of the story and bringing it out in our movements. Mr. Godeshwar essentially worked on building an aura and leaving your presence on stage long after you've exited. Speech should not be limited only to words and dialogues but should create a link between the actor and the audience was his training motto. The first run through was an impactful moment and nothing less than a milestone in this workshop. The students understood what the play was trying to tell us, how strong its message is and how much more we need to contribute to it. It was one of the most emotionally moving aspect of this workshop. Further to this came the stages of property development, set development, lighting and music settings and most importantly the art of projection techniques. The participants actively worked through the nitty-gritties of the play. Among other things was understanding how to use the stage space and exploring all possibilities of the set that was so vigorously made.

One thing that this workshop taught everybody all is that 'Theatre' is not just being on stage and delivering dialogues. It's about understanding others and more importantly, ourselves. From getting rid of inhibitions, stage fears and mental blocks to knowing that no matter how quirky you might be, theatre accepts you for who you are. It taught us that no role is big or small. We're all working as a cohesive unit which might break and fall if one of us is lax. This is a place where we find solace among a whole team. A little bit of you can be found in everyone.

On the occasion of World Mental Health Day, the students of the IISU Theatrical Society presented a theatrical production that touched topics ranging from social stigmas about mental health to the root causes of issues which lead to suicides. The skit began with the topic of harrasment based on abilities and appearances students face in their day to day lives. In the time where we look for peers who are perfect in all ways and fit the labels that look good on social media. The pressure to look a certain way to be a part of all social settings. The second scene highlighted the unhealthy competition in the teen world to secure jobs so as to have a successful lifestyle, approved by society. The act revolved around how everyone is racing to be first, to be the richest and it doesn't matter whether you're happy running this race. You just have to keep going or be trampled. The very next scene talked about emotionally exhaustive and abusive relationships people fall into. It was an issue that was an important highlight, because as young adults, we all need to understand how to cope with heartbreak and where to draw the lines. Most significant of all was the fact that we tend to lose our identity when engaged in a relationship. This is the most distressing part of the young adult phase.

The final scene was based on the sensitive issue of social discrimination. This scene held great emotional momentum as the actors recited Rohith Vemula's suicide letter. Rohith Vemula was one of the five Dalit students in JNU who faced social boycott at the hands of the university administration. His suicide brought to everyone's notice the mental abuse and humiliation faced by Dalits in all social settings.

Overall, the performance was a cocktail of all issues that in very small ways affects mental health in our everyday lives. Every 40 seconds, one person commits suicide. Every 40 seconds, a life goes untended to, helpless and unheard. There's a lot that we can do to help people around them. We can create awareness, inform people that mental health is not a taboo. It's okay to not be okay.

It was a great experience of being part of the **JAIRANGAM Master Classes 2019.** A very prestigious opportunity given by THE IIS UNIVERSITY to us, in which we had attended master classes conducted by the 5 masters of different arts and its relevance in theatre from 20<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2019.



On the 20<sup>th</sup> & 21th May the classes were conducted by Ranjit Kapoor Sir, who is a great theatre director and an alumna of NSD who has also taught at NSD. He taught us about a good script and the technique of writing a good play. He showed us a play directed by him in early 90's and a movie which is a satire on the Indian politics and politicians by which he taught about how can we convey our message in a creative and symbolic way in a creative manner.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> May the class was conducted by Amit Kalla Sir who is a very talented and experienced painter and is an alumna of JNU. He taught us about the relevance of painting and sculptures in theatre, Indian architecture, proof of theatre practices in the Indian mythological books paintings in sculptures. He introduced us with the stage paintings and how creative and beautifully they were used in the theatre performances in early times.



On the 24<sup>th</sup> May the class was conducted by Sanjay Upadhyay sir, founder director of MP School of Drama. He is a leading theatre director, singer and music composer in Indian theatre. His musical plays have travelled all over the world. He taught us about the relevance of music in the theatre, types of the music and music instruments, important features of music instruments, his experiences till now with and in the world of music and how we can use it in the theatre production or in the life.

On 25<sup>th</sup> May the class was conducted by Souti Chakraborty Sir. He was associated with the "Grips" theatre in Kolkata for six years. He graduated from the NSD in 2001 with the specialization in design and direction. He worked with the NSD repertory company for 7 years as designer, director and actor. He taught us about the functions of the lights, color, mood and proper selection of the lights according to the season, climate and the sensitivity of the scenes in the play. He told us that lights decide our psychology and mental state. Increasing lights increases the energy. Lights create the perception of our life.
